JUDGMENT


THIS MOTION, made by the Plaintiffs for judgment in accordance with the statement of claim was heard this day at Kitchener, Ontario.

ON READING the statement of claim, the motion record of the Plaintiffs, on hearing the submissions of counsel for the Plaintiffs,

1. THIS COURT ORDERS AND ADJUDGES that the Plaintiffs be granted a permanent injunction restraining the defendant Chris Carter from publishing, circulating, distributing, communicating or otherwise transmitting libellous or slanderous words or allegations against the plaintiffs or the Children's Aid Society of the Regional Municipality of Waterloo, also known as Family and Children's Services of the Waterloo Region or any of its staff members.
